As a leading supplier of flexible packaging, we are aiming to develop and produce packaging with a minimum of environmental impact. In line with this we guide our customers about packaging designed for recycling and possible choice of materials, which are not fossil-based.

- As a minimum we will obey the national legislation valid for our company, including a continuous supervision of our emissions to the surroundings
- It is important for us to have a good dialogue with the authorities, customers, and suppliers
- We are making yearly statements on energy and raw material consumption as well as waste amounts, and we are separating at source and reusing our industrial waste in the extent, where it is practically possible
- We are focused on our resource consumption and environmental impact, and consequently we evaluate our possibilities for improvements and optimisation of our production equipment regularly, including a conversion from gas to electric power. Furthermore, environmental aspects are taken into consideration before purchasing new machines or implementation of new processes
- Together with 11 other companies we have entered into a PPA-agreement with the Danish energy company “Energi Danmark”, which means an active supply of new, renewable energy to the society. In this way we have signed a purchase contract for our current demand for electric power from a solar park as soon as it has been built
